ORDINANCE NO. 272

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING FOR THE BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL RESOURCES OF REGULATIONS FOR FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Northumberland in Town Council assembled, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same;

Section I. The Borough of Northumberland doth enact and ordain by reference the rules and regulations of the Department of Environmental Resources Chapter 151 governing food establishments. Said regulations were dated and adopted on September 8, 1971. These regulations are adopted as regulations for the Health Department of the Borough of Northumberland by reference.

Section II. The Borough of Northumberland doth adopt any changes in said regulations made from time to time by the Department of Environmental Resources regulating food establishments. Before the adoption of said changes in the regulations, the Health Officials shall present said changes to the Council who by resolution may adopt the changes as regulations for the Health Department of the Borough of Northumberland.

Section III. All persons and Corporations violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of \$100.00 for each violation and each daily occurrence of the same offense shall be considered a new offense and finable as such. In default of payment of the fine, the offender shall be imprisoned in the county jail for a period not exceeding 5 days.

Section IV. All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
