

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND APPROVING THE ENGINEER'S REPORT OF BUCHART-HORN CERTIFYING THAT IN IT'S OPINION THE ESTIMATED NET REVENUES FROM SEWER RENTALS WILL BE SUFFICIENT FOR EACH YEAR DURING THE LIFE OF THE \$285,000.00 SEWER REVENUE BONDS TO PAY THE ANNUAL DEBT SERVICE ON SAID BONDS.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Northumberland, Northumberland County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of said Council as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Northumberland hereby approves the Engineer's Report of Buchart-Horn certifying that in it's opinion the estimated net revenues from sewer rentals will be sufficient for each year during the life of the \$285,000.00 Sewer Revenue Bonds to pay the maintenance costs and the annual debt service on said bonds.

Section 2. All ordinances or resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions in so far as they are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or rescinded.
