

BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND

RESOLUTION AWARDING CONTRACTS FOR SEWER PROJECT 277-B

WHEREAS, on March 6, 1974, the Borough Council adopted a resolution expressing its intention to award certain construction contracts for the constructing and equipping of expanded treatment facilities for the Borough's sewage system, subject to obtaining appropriate documentation and receipt of all requisite governmental approvals.

AND WHEREAS, the Borough has now completed the issuance of its Guaranteed Sewer Revenue Bonds, Series 1974, and has received permission from the federal government agency providing a grant for the above mentioned project to award construction contracts.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that:

(1) The construction bids of the following named bidders, being the lowest responsible bidders for the contract specified, are hereby accepted, conditioned upon the receipt from said bidders of performance and payment bonds, proof of insurance and executed contract documents, all conforming to the requirements of the plans and specifications prepared by Buchart-Horn, Inc., the Borough's Consulting Engineers:

(2) The appropriate Borough officials are hereby authorized to award contracts and to execute and deliver contract documents with the above named contractors upon advice by the Borough Solicitor that all the above named conditions have been fulfilled.

(3) The above mentioned action shall not constitute a rejection of the bids made by any other bidders for the sewage construction project, which bids shall be deemed rejected only upon the execution of contracts with the
