RESOLUTION

NO. 290

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE PRIESTLEY-FORSYTH MEMORIAL LIBRARY TO BE THE AGENT OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND FOR CERTAIN PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Priestley-Forsyth Memorial Library was established to provide free public library service, we hereby authorize and designate the Library to act as the agent of the borough government to provide public library service to the residents and taxpayers of the borough for and on behalf of the borough government.

In accord with Section 411 of The Library Code, the Borough Council will appoint one person to serve as its representative on the Board of Directors of the Priestley-Forsyth Memorial Library, this representative to serve 5 years.

In accord with Section 412 of The Library Code the Board of Directors shall prepare and present to the Borough Council a budget for the following year and such reports as are required by Sections 413 and 414 of The Library Code and shall give free library service to the residents and taxpayers as provided in Section 415 of The Library Code.
