

ORDINANCE NO. 307

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE PAVING OF AN UNNAMED ALLEY IN THE BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND EXTENDING FROM THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF ORANGE STREET TO THE SOUTHWESTERLY LINE OF WALLACE AVENUE, SAID ALLEY EXTENDS PARALLEL TO WATER STREET AND FRONT STREET AND IS LOCATED BETWEEN SAID STREETS, AND ALSO, ASSESSING THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS ON SAID ALLEY.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Borough of Northumberland in Town Council assembled and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same:

Section 1. An unnamed alley in the Borough of Northumberland from the northeasterly line of Orange Street to the southwesterly line of Wallace Avenue, said alley extends parallel to Water and Front Streets and is located between said streets is hereby directed to be paved with a permanent type pavement together with necessary grading and draining. The work shall be done with the purchase of necessary materials with labor to be furnished by Borough workmen.

Section 2. The costs and expenses of the entire work shall be paid by the Borough of Northumberland and the owners of real estate bounded or abutting on said streets in accordance with the Act of Assembly approved February 1, 1966, No. 581 Section 1761 at least one third (1/3) of the paving to be paid by the Borough and the same is hereby appropriated herefore out of the funds now or hereafter in the treasury and the balance not more than two thirds (2/3) of the paving to be paid by the owners of real estate bounding or abutting on said streets and the same is hereby assessed and the assessments appropriated therefore.

Section 3. All ordinances or resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
