LEVYING TAXES ON PER CAPITA, EARNED INCOME TAX AND OCCUPATIONAL PRIVILEGE

LEVYING TAXES ON PER CAPITA, EARNED INCOME TAX AND OCCUPATIONAL FOR THE YEAR 1978 IN THE BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND, NORTHUMBERLAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ORDINANCES NO. 220 and 221, ADOPTED MARCH 3, 1964, WHICH ORDINANCES LEVIED A PER CAPITA TAX \$5.00 A YEAR AND LEVIED A TAX ON EARNED INCOME OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND AND CONTINUING THE PROVISIONS OF ORDINANCE NO. 267 APPROVED DECEMBER 19, 1972, KNOWN AS OCCUPATIONAL PRIVILEGE ORDINANCE

SECTION 1. The provisions of Ordinance No. 220 approved March 3, 1964 which ordinance levied a per capita tax of \$5.00 a year is hereby continued for the year 1978, all provisions of the ordinance shall be continued and are adopted by reference.

SECTION 2. The provisions of Ordinance No. 221, approved March 3, 1964 which ordinance is known as the Earned Income Tax Ordinance is continued for the year 1978 and for successive years or until said ordinance has been revoked or annulled, all provisions as set forth in said ordinance shall be continued and are adopted by reference.

SECTION 3. The provisions of Ordinance No. 267 approved December 29, 1972 which ordinance is known as the Occupational Privilege Ordinance is continued for the year 1978 and for successive years or until said ordinance has been revoked or annulled, all provisions as set forth in said ordinance shall be continued and are adopted by reference.

Pursuant to the LOCAL TAX ENABLING ACT OF DECEMBER 31, 1967, P. L. 1257, Section 4, as amended, the aforesaid taxes shall continue in force on a calander or fiscal year basis, as the case may be, without annual reenactment unless the rate of tax is subsequently changed.
