

ORDINANCE # 326

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND, PENNSYLVANIA, ELECTING TO JOIN THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT SYSTEM UNDER ARTICLE IV OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW; AGREEING TO BE BOUND BY ALL PROVISIONS OF THE PENNSYLVANIA MUNICIPAL RETIREMENT LAW, AS AMENDED AND AS APPLICABLE TO MEMBER MUNICIPALITIES JOINING UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE; STATING WHICH OF CERTAIN OPTIONS PERMITTED UNDER THE SAID LAW ARE ACCEPTED.

Be it Ordained and Enacted, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the Council of the Borough of Northumberland, Pennsylvania as follows:

SECTION I. The Borough of Northumberland hereby elects to join the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System, established by the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law, Act 15, 1974, as amended, under Article IV of said Law, and does hereby agree to be bound by all the requirements and provisions of the said Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law and the amendments thereto and to assume all obligations, financial and otherwise; placed upon member municipalities by said Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Law and the amendments thereto.

SECTION II. Credit for all prior service of each original member shall be for total years of service to the Borough of Northumberland. The Borough of Northumberland does hereby assume the liability for payment of 100 per centum for the prior service for each original member.

SECTION III. As part of this Ordinance the Borough of Northumberland agrees to the outline of benefits set forth in the agreement attached to this Ordinance covering all police employees.

SECTION IV. A duly certified copy of this Ordinance shall be filed with the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement Board of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and membership for the Borough of Northumberland in the Pennsylvania Municipal Retirement System shall be effective the Seventh day of December, 1976.
