

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT made this 21st day of July, 1983,
by and between the POINT TOWNSHIP SEWER AUTHORITY, of Point Township,
Northumberland County, Pennsylvania (hereinafter called Authority) and
the BOROUGH OF NORTHUMBERLAND, of Northumberland County, Pennsylvania
(hereinafter called Borough),

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Authority intends to construct a sanitary sewage
collection system in Point Township, in the area of Route 11, Diner
Road, Oak Park and the surrounding area, and desires to have the Borough
accept and treat the sewage and waste from said sanitary sewage collectin
system; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is willing to accept and treat the sewage
and waste from the sanitary sewage collection system to be constructed
by the Authority as recited above, and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to enter into an agreement
concerning the acceptance and treatment of said sewage, the rates for
treatment and all other related matters.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed as follows:

1. The Authority shall at its own cost and expense:
 - a. Construct a sanitary sewage collection system in
Point Township, in the area of Route 11, Diner Road, Oak Park

and the surrounding area and connect the same to the Borough's fifteen (15) inch sewer main in Priestley Avenue at or near the intersection of Orange Street.

b. Install a (y) or short stub in the Authority's force main at a point in the Borough to be selected by the Borough for possible future use by the Borough as a connection to said force main.

2. The Borough shall accept, treat and dispose of all sewage and waste emanating from the Authority's sanitary sewage collection system in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth in this Agreement.

3. The Authority shall pay to the Borough for the treatment of sewage and waste from the Authority's sanitary sewage collection system the same rate that the Borough charges its customers. Said payments shall be made to the Borough quarterly in April, July, October and January.

4. The Authority shall adopt the Borough's sewer rules and regulations as the minimum requirement of the Authority. No change in said rules and regulations shall be made by the Authority without prior

approval of the Borough.

5. The Authority shall not enter into any industrial waste discharge agreements without prior approval by the Borough.

6. The Authority Auditor shall each year furnish to the Borough a certificate concerning the number of billable E.D.U.'s for said year.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have caused this Agreement to be signed by their duly authorized officers, and to be sealed with their seals.
