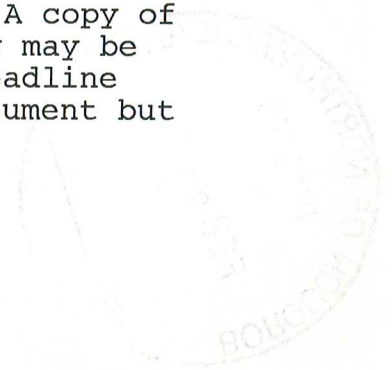

Dear Ms. Sanders:

As you may have recently heard or read in the local newspapers there has been a great deal of renewed interest in the Route 901 improvement project. The project has been placed on the third part of PENN DOT's Twelve Year Plan however with recent developments concerning Industrial and Economic Development many persons would like to try to push the time frame from the third part to the first four years of that plan. The project would improve connections between Interstate 81 and Legislative Routes 61 and 54. Although the impact of such a project may seem to benefit the immediate area, providing easier accessibility to Northumberland County will benefit all Susquehanna Valley Communities.


County and local officials and business leaders are preparing to offer testimony on behalf of the project and need your support to make this project a reality. I have included a sample resolution to express your municipalities support (your solicitor may wish to adopt your own version which is fine, this is only a sample. You may want to review this with him before the meeting.) All resolutions will be included with a package being assembled which will be presented to PENN D.O.T. at the February 26th hearing along with other oral and written support for the project.

I apologize for the unavoidable short notice but please return the resolution as soon as possible so it may be included with the text to be presented. If it is not possible for you to formally adopt the resolution before the hearing you still can show support for the project. A copy of the resolution to be adopted at your regular meeting may be used with a letter of explanation that due to the deadline requirement you were unable to submit the signed document but it will be executed at the next meeting.



Should you have any questions please call. There is much competition for time at this hearing. If we are to make a favorable impression for our case we need the support of everyone in whatever capacity that may be. Thank you.
