WHEREAS, A Hazardous Waste Incinerator is being proposed for Gregg Township, Union County, Pennsylvania; and

WHEREAS, The waste coming to this incinerator may travel over Route 15 and Route 147 by truck or by rail through the Borough of Northumberland; and


WHEREAS, A toxic chemical spill or accident could be devastating to the residents of this area; and

WHEREAS, The effects of the incinerator according to available information are not yet known; and

WHEREAS, The Northumberland Borough Council is charged with protecting the health and welfare of the residents of the Borough of Northumberland;

THEREFORE, The Borough of Northumberland joins with Gregg Township in support for formal opposition to the construction of a Hazardous Waste Incinerator for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the area east of Route 15, just north of Allenwood, Gregg Township, Union County.

RESOLUTION

R-12-91

BE IT RESOLVED, and it is hereby resolved by the Council of the Borough of Northumberland, that the sewer charge for the year 1992 is as follows:

(1) One Hundred-Twenty Dollars (\$120.00) per annum, payable at the rate of Thirty Dollars (\$30.00) per quarter-annum for each dwelling unit charged on a dwelling unit basis and for each equivalent dwelling unit charged on an equivalent dwelling unit basis.

(2) One Dollar and Forty-Nine Cents (\$1.49) per one thousand gallon payable quarter-annually for those units or entities charged on a water usage basis.
